### 2nd Type



# A hypothetical condition and its probable result

IF+PAST SIMPLE OR
WOULD+VERB WITHOUT TO

If you went to bed earlier you would not be so tired.



### 3rd Type



An unreal past condition and its probable result in the past

IF+PAST PERFECT OR
WOULD HAVE+PAST PARTICIPLE

If you had studied harder you would have passed the exam.




## Mixed Type



An unreal past condition and its probable result in the present

PAST PERFECT+PERFECT

If we had looked at the map we wouldn't be lost.



#### Zero Type



An unreal past condition and its probable result in the present

IF+PRESENT SIMPLE

If you heat ice it melts.
