

Whatever it is, I'm against it!








OTCYTCTBOBATE

I'll be back around 10:00 tonight.






## To Be For

She has no idea what she's in for, does she?






### To Be Out

Henry's birthday party is almost over.






#### To Be In

I know you've sometimes felt shut out.






## To Shut Down

I was talking too much, they asked me to shut up. How rude!






## To Come In

Выйти


Can I come out of this room?

Do you know what's about to come down on your heads?






#### To Come Down with

I could come down with a fever.






#### To Come Round
